Cleaning and Care

Periodically wipe Fixture with a soft, dry cloth.

Avoid harsh or abrasive chemicals as
finish damage may result.





STEP 1: ASSEMBLE FIXTURE BODY

Carefully turn pipe on Fixture Body (B) into place by threading and hand tightening until secure.



Do not twist fixture cord while turning these pieces together.

STEP 2: ASSEMBLE MOUNTING HARDWARE Attach Nipple (C) to Mounting Bracket (I) and a use Hex Nut (J) and Lock Washer (H) on each side to lock

in place.

Thread Canopy Loop (G) onto longer end of Nipple.

STEP 3: ATTACH MOUNTING HARDWARE


Attach Mounting Hardware to Junction Box using Mounting Screws (D). Use screwdriver to firmly tighten and secure.




STEP 4: ATTACH CHAIN / ADD HARDWARE


Determine drop measurement (ceiling to bottom of fixture) and adjust Chain (K) by adding/removing links. Open Lock Buckle and attach one end to Loop on top of Fixture Body (B). Slide Collar (F), followed by Canopy (A) down Chain and allow rest on top of Fixture. Open Lock Buckle on other end of Chain then lift and hang entire Fixture from Canopy Loop (G).

NOTE: Close both Lock Buckles after attaching.


STEP 5: WEAVE CORD/WIRE

Gently thread wire through Collar (F) and Canopy (A) then weave through Chain (K) about every third link.

Next, carefully thread wire through hole in Canopy Loop (G) and pull into Juction Box and prepare for electrical connection in next step.

Permit wires to hang freely next to Chain.







STEP 6: CONNECT ELECTRICAL

Trim wires leaving at least 6" to make electrical connection. Strip ends of 3/4" insulation. Attach bare (or green) ground wire from fixture to bare (or green) ground wire in junction box using Wire Connector (E). Wrap both around green ground screw on Mounting Bracket (I) and firmly tighten.

TO AVOID ELECTRICAL SHOCK, WIRE FOR CORRECT POLARITY: Connect wires BLACK (or smooth) to *BLACK. Connect wires WHITE (or ribbed along the edge) to WHITE. Firmly secure with Wire Connectors. SEE INSET BELOW:

* Black wire may be red in some installations.









STEP 7: COVER JUNCTION BOX

Slide Ceiling Canopy (A) over Junction Box followed by Collar (F). Thread Collar onto Canopy Loop (G) and tighten until Canopy is firmly pressed against ceiling.

STEP 8: INSTALL BULBS

Sockets on this Fixture rated up to 60 Watt Maximum Type B (candelabra) Bulbs.
*LED bulbs may be used and permit a choice of brighter bulb without exceeding socket rating.
To mimic the color of an incandescent, choose 2700K Soft White.
